Who can enter?

Any child attending an Australian primary school can enter this competition. Students can enter individually or as part of a combined school effort. The competition is judged in three categories:

- Category 1: Foundation Year (Prep) and Year 1
- Category 2: Years 2, 3 and 4
- Category 3: Years 5 and 6

Great prizes!

A 1st, 2nd, and 3rd prize winner will be selected from each category by a panel of judges. Each winner will receive a brain-related prize pack. Each winner's school will receive a brain-related resource pack and a voucher to buy further resources from Modern Teaching Aids (\$1000 for 1st, \$500 for 2nd, and \$250 for 3rd prize winners). Each 1st prize winner's school will also receive a special visit from some of our young and enthusiastic brain researchers.
